**RAPID ALERT**

**DRUG PRODUCTS DECLARED SPURIOUS BY THE PROVINCIAL  
DRUG TESTING LABORATORY, PESHAWAR, KPK**

**Target Audience:**

- Drug Inspector at DRAP and Provinces.
- Healthcare Professionals (Physicians, Pharmacists & Nurses).
- Hospitals and Other Treatment Centers.
- General Public.

**Alert Summary:**

The Drug Testing Laboratory Peshawar, under the Government Analyst, has reported the following drug products as **Spurious/unregistered**. Laboratory testing confirmed the absence of the declared active pharmaceutical ingredient(s), as defined under Section 23(1)(a)(i) and (vii) of the of the Drugs Act, 1976, and must not be used due to the risk of treatment failure and potential harm to patients.

**Risk Statement:**

These products include progestogens, antibiotics, ophthalmic antibacterials, antivertigo agents, antiseptics/disinfectants, muscle relaxants, vitamin D preparations, and proton-pump inhibitors. In products declared spurious, laboratory testing failed to identify the stated active ingredient, indicating that they may provide no therapeutic benefit. Use of these products may result in treatment failure, disease progression, serious complications, and potentially life-threatening outcomes, particularly in vulnerable patients.

**Action Initiated:**

The Regulatory Field Force (CDIs, SDIs and PDIs) of DGDC&PS has been directed to conduct surveillance activities throughout the supply chain to confiscate the falsified products.

**Advice for Healthcare Professionals:**

DGDC&PS requests healthcare professionals to have increased vigilance within the supply chains of institutions/pharmacies/healthcare facilities likely to be affected by above mentioned product. Any adverse events or quality problems experienced with the use of these products should be reported to National or Provincial pharmacovigilance centers using Adverse
